In 1907, Picasso created Les Femmes d'Alger , a large painting nearly eight feet square, that aggressively disregarded any sense of traditional artistic perspective Instead, Picasso reduced its five nude figures to two-dimensional geometric forms Les Femmes d'Alger planted the seeds for Cubism

and was a foundational work of modern art
